Anonymous Reports

Individuals wishing to remain anonymous may file an anonymous complaint in any manner with the University's Title IX Coordinator or the System Office of Equal Opportunity. However, electing to remain anonymous may greatly limit the ability to investigate an alleged incident, collect evidence, and/or take effective action against individuals accused of sexual misconduct in violation of University policy.

Supportive Measures

The University will offer a range of supportive measures to the parties, including, but not limited to: separation or modification of academic or working situations; mutual restrictions on contact; one-way restrictions on contact, where justified by the specific facts and circumstances; permissive withdrawal from or retake of a class without penalty; counseling; extensions of deadlines or other course-related adjustments; campus escort services; leaves of absence; increased security and monitoring of certain areas of campus; or any other similar measures tailored to the individualized ne

DEFINITIONS

Complainant:

An individual who was allegedly subject to conduct that could constitute a violation of Texas Tech University System Regulations 07.06A or 07.06B.

Consent:

Mutually understandable words or actions, actively communicated both knowingly and voluntarily, that clearly convey permission for a specific activity. Consent is not effective if it results from: (a) the use of physical force; (b) a threat of physical force; (c) intimidation; (d) coercion; (e) incapacitation; or (f) any other factor that would eliminate an individual's
