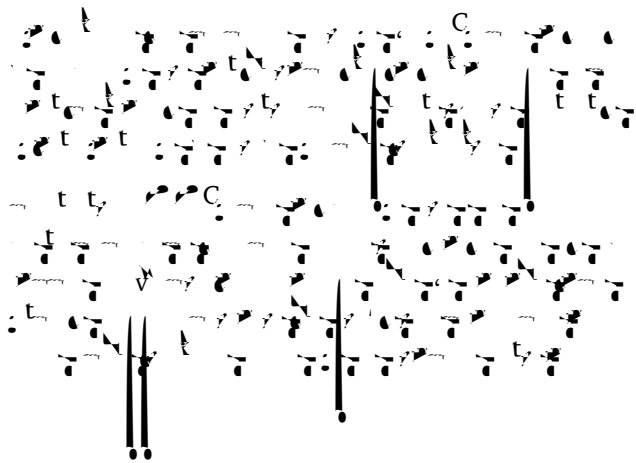
# THE COMPASS ROSE

from childhood to maturity and youth to old age.

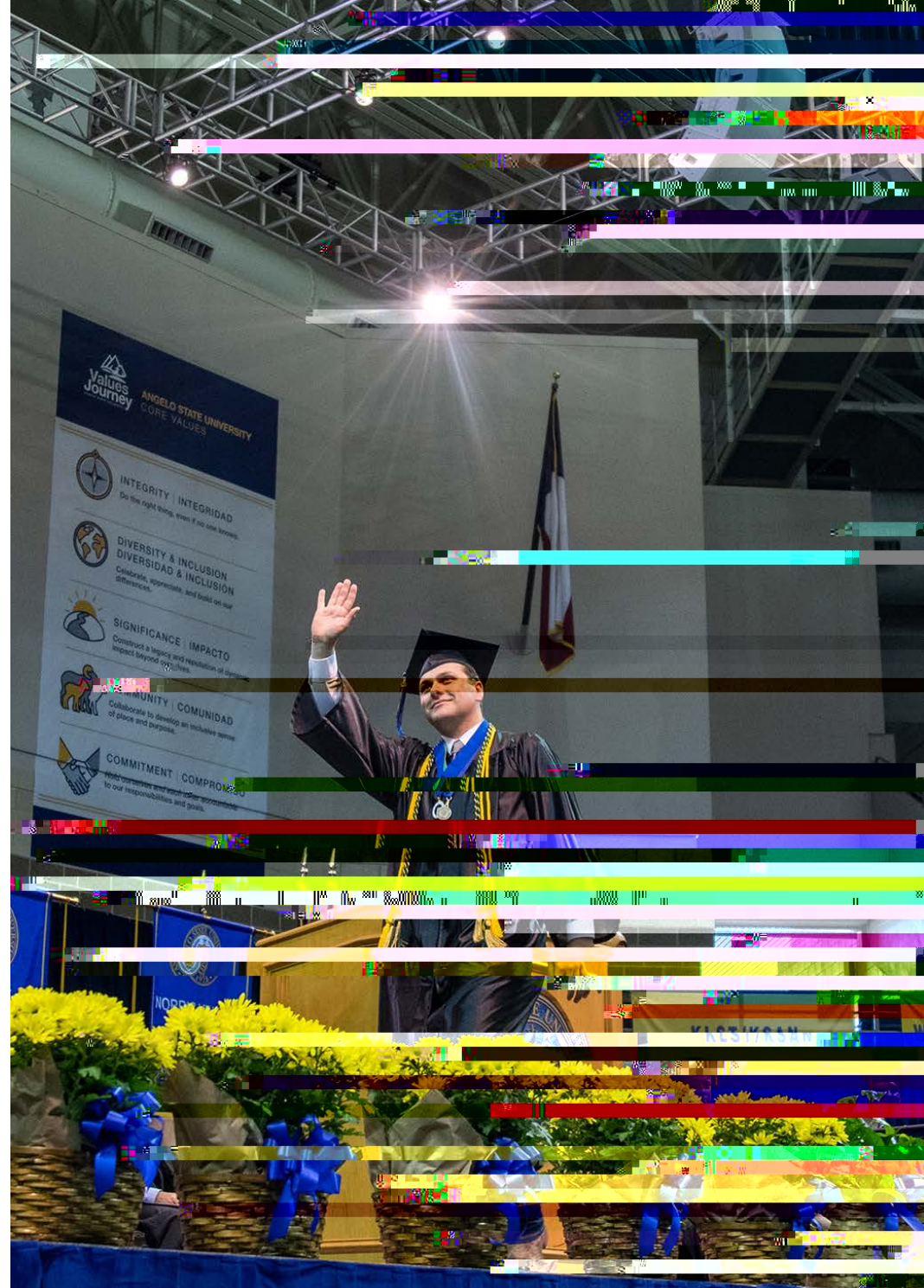
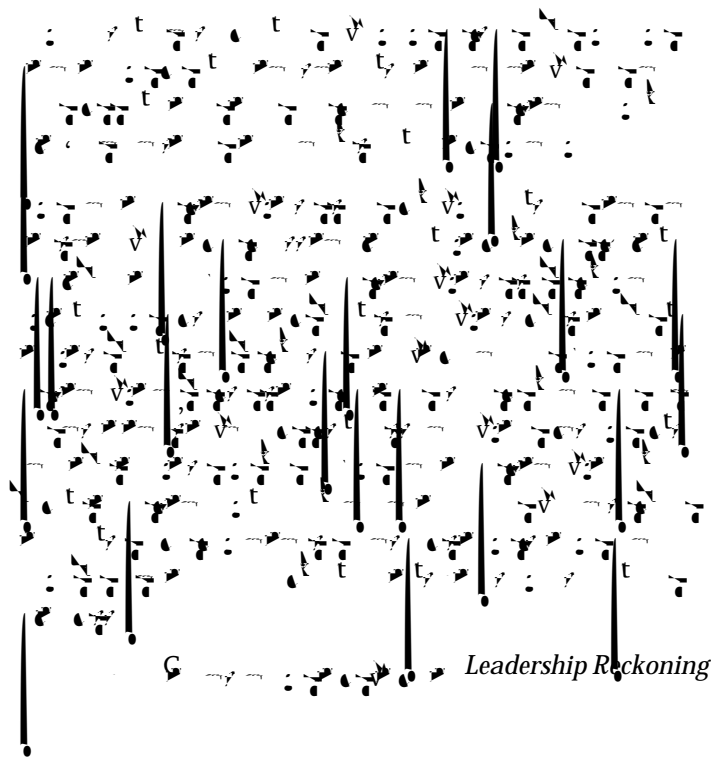
From innocence to awareness and ignorance to knowing;
